I DESIRE TO RESPECTFULLY REQUEST YOU TO FIX MY STATUS WITH REGARD TO THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE WHICH I AM DESIROUS OF OBTAINING IN YOUR UNIVERSITY. I DESIRE TO CLAIM SOME EXEMPTION UNDER REGULATION 10.

I PRESUME THAT THE MATRICULATION EXAMINATION IN THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE IS TAKEN AS THE CORRESPONDING EXAMINATION TO YOUR HIGHER PUBLIC EXAMINATION. I THEREFORE ENCLOSE YOU CERTIFICATES OF PASSING ALL THAT IS REQUIRED IN THAT PARTICULAR. I PRESUME REGULATION 9 APPLIES TO THIS.

FROM 1877 TO 1881 INCLUSIVE I FOLLOWED THE COURSE OF FIVE YEARS FOR M.B. IN THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE PASSING THE EXAMINATIONS OF THE FIRST, THE SECOND, THE THIRD AND THE FOURTH YEARS, AND FAILING IN ONE SUBJECT IN THE FIFTH YEAR. DURING 1878 I ATTENDED ALSO THE LECTURES PRESCRIBED FOR AND PASSED THE NECESSARY EXAMINATION FOR B.C.E. ^{the first year for.} I THEREFORE ENCLOSE YOU CERTIFICATES OF THE FOLLOWING EXAMINATIONS, CORRESPONDING COURSES OF LECTURES HAVING BEEN ATTENDED BY ME:-

1. LOWER MATHEMATICS. (AS FOR 1ST YEAR ARTS.)
2. ELEMENTARY NATURAL PHILOSOPHY. (PHYSICS.) (AS FOR 1ST YEAR ARTS)
3. PRACTICAL CHEMISTRY. (LABORATORY.)
4. MEDICAL CHEMISTRY.
5. GENERAL ANATOMY PHYSIOLOGY AND PATHOLOGY. (THIS IS THE PHYSIOLOGY COURSE FOR THE 3RD YEAR M.B. CERTIFICATE IN BOOK NO 13.)
6. GENERAL ANATOMY PHYSIOLOGY AND PATHOLOGY. (THIS IS THE PHYSIOLOGY COURSE FOR THE 4TH YEAR M.B. CERTIFICATE IN BOOK NO 18.)

7. CHEMISTRY AND MINERALOGY. (AS FOR 1ST YEAR ARTS AND 1ST YEAR ENGINEERING.)
 8. BOTANY. (AS PRESCRIBED FOR THE ARTS COURSE AND MEDICAL COURSE.)
 9. PRACTICAL MENSURATION (AS PRESCRIBED FOR THE 1ST YEAR FOR B.C.E.)
 10. SURFACE AND MINING SURVEYING AND LEVELLING. (AS PRESCRIBED FOR THE 1ST YEAR FOR B.C.E.)
 11. DRAWING AND MAPPING. (AS PRESCRIBED FOR THE 1ST YEAR FOR B.C.E.)
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I TRUST THAT YOU WILL FAVOURABLY CONSIDER THIS APPLICATION AND THAT YOU WILL GRANT ME THE EXEMPTIONS THE ABOVE EXAMINATIONS SHOULD ENTITLE ME TO.

I ALSO RESPECTFULLY DESIRE TO SOLICIT YOU TO GRANT ME AN EXEMPTION FROM ATTENDANCE ON LECTURES ON THE GROUND OF MY RESIDENCE IN ANOTHER COLONY OR STATE, AND THAT OWING TO MY PROFESSIONAL WORK DEMANDING MY PRESENCE HERE IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR ME TO RESIDE IN ADELAIDE.
