Dear Mr. Wodge

I learn from Bate
that I am timed to arrive in
Adelaide a week later than you
expect. I have gone through the
hour very carefully, and it is im-
possible to close it up at all.
It also does not allow for my
calling at Mount Gambier on the
way. Don't you think, in the
circumstances, it will be best to
let Moore take Mount Gambier
on the way from Melbourne, and
finish off any other country centres

which it may be impossible for me
to do? This is only a suggestion.
It is immaterial to me. The only
thing which I must insist upon
is the point which was raised by
me before I left England, and
which would have been attained
without any difficulty if I had not
had to interchange views with
Moore: that is, that I must
visit the Macedonia on Dec. 14th.
Subject to that stipulation, I
am entirely in the hands of you
and Bulch.

I leave here to-morrow, and go
straight to Ipswich. I can give
you my addresses in that country for
few days and much travelling, but
I shall be in Melbourne for a fortnight
from Oct. 4. Mr J. Bramhall Esq.,
424 Chancery Lane, will find me
here. - With kind regards
